Position Description

A BLM Rangeland Management Specialist manages the range plants on public land for livestock forage, watershed and soil protection, wildlife forage, and recreation uses. The Rangeland Management Specialist works with ranchers, wildlife biologists, environmentalists, and other interested parties to develop long-term management plans for sustaining healthy range plants while meeting the needs of diverse users. The Rangeland Management Specialist ensures the successful implementation and consistent evaluation of those management plans.

Community Information

Located in southwestern Utah near the Arizona border, the quiet town of Kanab has a population of approximately 4300. Kanab is surrounded by a variety of western geologic scenery ranging from coral pink cliffs and sand dunes, volcanic craters and lava flows, to deep canyons, majestic mountains and spacious plains. The natural beauty, plentiful sunshine and consistently mild weather of the Kanab area have made it a popular place. Kanab is considered a natural hub location for visits to Zion, Bryce and Grand Canyon National Parks, Grand Staircase/Escalante National Monument and Glen Canyon National Recreational Area. Other nearby national monuments and colorful state parks make Kanab a natural base with quality services for a weekend get-away, an extended vacation, or a great place to live and experience these exciting destinations and typical "Southwestern" recreational activities.
