Arizona; California-Pacific – California, Hawaii, and all the lands in the Pacific not currently associated with the following: Mexico and Pacific Northwest Sections of SRM, the state of Alaska, Australia; **Colorado; Florida; Idaho; International Mountain** – Alberta, Western Montana; **Kansas; Mexico; National Capital** – Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont, Virginia, West Virginia; **Nebraska; Nevada; New Mexico; North Central** – Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio, Ontario, Quebec, Wisconsin; **Northern Great Plains** – Eastern Montana, Manitoba, North Dakota, Saskatchewan; **Oklahoma; Pacific Northwest** – British Columbia, Oregon, Washington; **South Dakota; Southern** – Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee; **Texas; Utah; Wyoming; Unsectioned** – Alaska, Puerto Rico, & all other foreign countries

MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS

Regular – Basic individual membership includes *Rangeland News*, voting privileges, committee service, and nomination & election to any office.

Additional Family – Individuals of same household desiring more than one Regular membership. Families receive only one set of publications, but each member retains all rights & privileges of Regular member.

Student – Full-time students (high school through graduate school). Not eligible to hold office. Must succeed to different class of membership in the calendar year following termination of course of study.

Apprentice - A verified Student member is eligible as an Apprentice Member for five years following that time he/she has terminated his/her course of study. Not eligible to hold office. Must succeed to a different class of Membership in the sixth calendar year following his acceptance as an Apprentice.

Emeritus - A member is eligible for Emeritus membership in the year he/she becomes 55 years of age, or any year thereafter, provided he/she has retired and has maintained prior membership in the Society for at least 15 continuous years.

International – Member must reside in one of the countries listed above. Receives online access to both *Rangeland Ecology & Management* and *Rangelands Magazine*.

Life – Same as Regular with one-time dues payment.

Life Family – Individuals of same family desiring more than one Life membership.

Commercial – Businesses, proprietorships, individuals or other entities organized for profit. Must designate a representative. Listed in Society publications.

Institutional – Institutions or other entities not organized for profit (i.e. Federal agencies, livestock organizations, Indian tribes, universities). Membership is in institution's name with a designated representative. Not eligible to hold office. Listed in Society publications.
